FMG (REGULATION)

APPROVAL The Request for Extracurricular Trip Approval form should be sub-

mitted to the principal and then to the Superintendent [see FMG

(LOCAL)] at least five days prior to the date of departure.

TRANSPORTATION If the method of transportation requested is a school bus, approval

is contingent upon the availability of a school bus and a driver.

In general, students will be required to use District transportation for school-sponsored trips. In accordance with FMG (LOCAL), however, a parent may request that his or her child be allowed to ride with or be released after the event to the parent or another

adult designated by the parent.

CONSENT Each student must submit a form signed by a parent, giving per-

mission to participate in trips sponsored by the specific school or-

ganization.

SUPERVISING EMPLOYEES

District personnel must accompany students on all schoolsponsored trips and will assume responsibility for the students'

proper conduct.

The adults supervising any student trip will take with them copies of each student's Authorization to Secure Emergency Medical Treat-

ment.

CHAPERONES For trips of one day only, there should be a ratio of one adult for

each ten students in the elementary grades and one adult for each

fifteen students in the secondary grades.

For any overnight trip, there should be at least one adult for each

five students.

When both male and female students participate in a schoolsponsored overnight trip, they should be accompanied by at least

one male and one female sponsor.

The principal must approve all chaperones.

The expenses of chaperones for school-sponsored trips must be incorporated into the trip budget. Chaperones will be recruited at the earliest possible date and may participate in the fund-raising

activities of the student group to offset their expenses.

CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK In advance of any student overnight trip, the District will obtain the criminal history record of all persons serving as supervisors or

chaperones. [See GKG]

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
