
Do you feel that there is a need for additional security cameras?





I most need coaching/mentoring to improve instructional delivery?





- It would be great to have an officer at each campus, or at least one that could be split between two campuses.
- Would be nice to ensure each classroom has mini blinds, as we are asked to close them for intruder drills. More frequent drills.
- Not carry a weapon on them but have a locked safe in the classroom/office so that if it is needed
 one can be obtained easily.
- The district might consider having a military person on each campus. This could actually be part of their job....
- I think it would be great if everyone had to pass through a metal detector (patrolled by an officer) before entering at each campus. This would ensure that our students could not bring guns/knives into the school. I also think it would be a great safety measure to discontinue the use of lockers within the schools. 80-90% of school violence occurs when kids are at their lockers in passing and in the changing/locker rooms. I believe that locker rooms should be supervised by adult school personnel as well as the restrooms.
- I strongly believe that admin and teachers should be allowed to carry concealed weapons.
